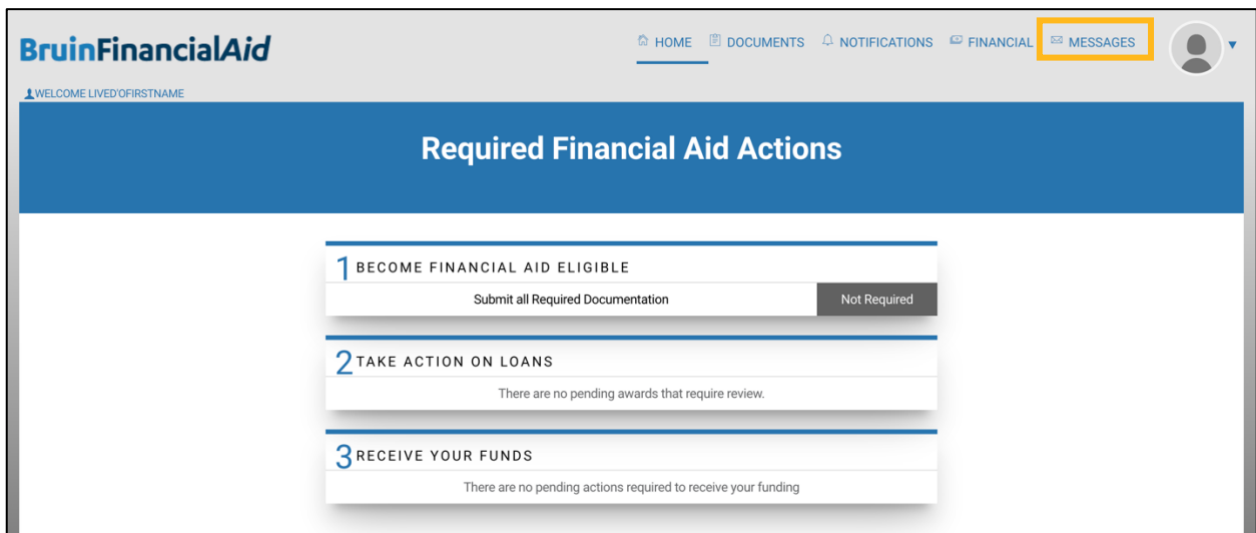

Viewing a College Financial Plan in the Bruin Financial Aid Portal

The college financial plan is a comprehensive document that outlines the estimated cost of attending UCLA and the resources available to you to help cover those costs. The college financial plan is found within the award letter.


1. From the homepage, click the **MESSAGES** tab.



2. Select the envelope to the left of the **Award Letter** from under the **Messages** section.

Check the status of your Financial aid file by logging into the Student Portal on MyUCLA, after completing the SIR, and submit any additional documentation that has been requested.
